Mission: The object of the Legion of Mary is the glory of God through the holiness of its members developed by prayer and active co-operation in Mary's and the Church's work.

Scale: It is the largest apostolic organization of lay people in the Catholic Church, featuring millions of members globally.

History: Founded in Dublin, Ireland, in 1921 by Frank Duff, the organization expanded to Canada around 1932.
