LITURGICAL LIFE

Liturgy Committee

The third advisory board, this committee, representing all the different ministries involved in the liturgical life of the parish; supports the planning of liturgical celebrations for all the seasons of the liturgical year.

Sacristan

Parishioners willing to learn local liturgical procedures, to set up and prepare for all liturgical celebrations at each of the Masses.

Mass Coordinators

Parishioners, generally experienced as Lectors or Eucharistic Ministers, willing to come approx. 30 minutes before Mass starts, to ensure the scheduled Lectors, Eucharistic Ministers and Altar Servers are present, and if not, to find alternates, at each of the week-end Masses.

Ushers

Parishioners over the age of 16, familiar with the physical set-up of our church, to show new and visiting parishioners to the pews, put envelopes on the pews, assist with offertory collections and respond to unforeseen circumstances.
Ensure pews are tidied after Mass.

Proclaimers

Parishioners, willing and capable of proclaiming, rather than reading, the Word of the Lord; must be able to proclaim clearly, slowly and reverently.

Ministers of Communion

Those, respectful of the Eucharist, willing to distribute the Body and Blood of Christ to fellow parishioners during Liturgical celebrations.

Altar Servers

Male & female, generally youth with a fair understanding of the sequence of our Mass and willing to serve for the weekend Masses.

Funeral Acolytes

Generally retired or shift workers, willing to serve for funerals and other special occasions.

Church Care- Light Cleaning/Dusting

Help clean and dust the church.

Library Maintenance

Organizing and maintaining library materials.

Musicians & Choirs

This involves any parishioners willing to practice and sing once weekly, and others able and willing to play a musical instrument or act as cantor.

PARISH LIFE

Pastoral Council Committee

An advisory board, representing the entire parish, promoting pastoral activity to help the parish set and achieve its goals.

Finance Council

An advisory board to the Pastor; who supports the financial and administrative aspects of parish life.

Sunday Collection Counters

Must be at least 18 years of age and an active participant in Parish worship and life. Must observe strict discretion and confidentiality in matters arising from Sunday Collection business.

Pastoral Care of the Sick

Mature parishioners willing to commit to visiting hospitals, care facilities or taking Eucharist to shut-ins. Includes Mass/monthly visits to HH Village Manor and lay communion service at Harris House. Pastoral care course is required, available through the Diocese. Contact the Parish Office for more information.

Bereavement Ministry

A parish support for those who have lost a loved one. Pastoral care course is required, available through the Diocese. Contact the Parish Office for more information.

Funeral Catering

Those willing to prepare and/or help serve at luncheons following funerals in the parish.

Couples for Christ

Inspire ministry and devotion – has a Family and Youth component.

Youth Ministry - Coordinator Needed

Parishioners willing to assist in offering opportunities for youth to integrate more fully into parish life and to mature in faith.

Maintenance Committee

Parishioners to share their talents, their skills and their labor.

Event Set-up and Take-down

Volunteers assists in converting the parish hall and meeting rooms for parish events and funeral receptions. Set up and take down of tables and chairs.
Must be available on short notice.

Church Watch

Parishioners to check the grounds of the Church and Hall at least one day per month, during daytime and at least once in the evening if possible.
Keep record of dates and send into the coordinator.

FAITH DEVELOPMENT

Rite of Christian Initiation as Adults (RCIA)

Parishioners willing to assist non-Catholics in the process of joining the Catholic Church. Full guidance given, beginning with the Inquiry phase, continuing through the Catechumenate and full membership.

Children's Sacrament Preparation

People willing to teach the sacramental program to children.
